# BADGE

BADGE is a project under the Lifelong Learning Programme financed by the European Commission.

The project aims to transfer and adapt an innovative support programme for double disadvantaged women to assist them starting up their own business by providing training through organized workshops on valuable soft skills and competences.

## **We want to achieve it by:**

- ✓ Adaptation of workshops for double disadvantaged women.
- ✓ Creating an on-line social platform for mutual support and exchange of experiences.
- ✓ Close cooperation with and adaptation of tools for VET teachers and trainers.

Based on an initial and in-depth research not many women decide on self-employment because they continue to perceive such career as to risky. 7% of European women (and 5.4% of men) declared they prefer working as employees because they are afraid of legal and social consequences in case of failure.

Unemployment among women is a concern for all partner countries. BADGE wants to mainstream business support and make it available to all women from diverse backgrounds.

## **As a result:**

- ✓ Many women will have better knowledge, skills and competences for running own business.
- ✓ VET specialists will have better insight on the needs of double disadvantaged women and will be able to provide better support.
