
ENVIRONMENTAL LEARNING ILLUSTRATED – ALSO CALLED “ILLUSTRATED CLIMATE”

E-LEARNING PROGRAMME


The Illustrated Climate online e-learning programme will consist of **four individual modules** including personal actions that lower our environmental impact. All four modules have interactive games and quiz questions to help participants track their learning. In addition to this, each module has a range of examples of organisations, local governments or companies that are reducing the consumption of energy and resources through their activities.

TRANSPORT




The Transport module covers the impact of the different types of transport and how the development of transport means might help to reduce the production of greenhouse gases.

LIFESTYLE




The Lifestyle module includes information about how our lifestyle choices impact the environment and how we can reduce this impact by choosing things that are produced differently and also to reuse, reduce, repair and recycle more.

CLIMATE



The Climate Change and Energy module covers the relationship between climate change and energy, including the scientific consensus that links climate change with human activities through the production of greenhouse gases and the international consensus reached in October 2009 in South Korea to limit the average increase in global temperatures by 1.5°C compared with pre-industrial levels.

FOOD



The Food module presents the relationship between the different stages of food production and their relationship to the production of greenhouse gases, including the impact of food waste. The module also has a section on water consumption and another section on the importance of conserving biodiversity.


