4 events have been carried out within this project:

Event 1

Participation: The event involved 323 citizens, including 63 participants from Mallorca (Spain),

41 participants from the city of Rzeszow (**Poland**), 53 participants from Umbria (**Italy**), 100 participants from the city of Vejle (**Denmark**) and 66 participants from the city of Lisbon (**Portugal**)

Location / Dates: The event took place in Mallorca (**Spain**), Rzeszow (**Poland**), Umbria (**Italy**), Vejle (**Denmark**) and Lisbon (**Portugal**), from 01.01.2019 to 28.02.2019

Short description: The aim of the event was he projects' target group to answer questions allowing them to speak freely on matters of EU policy. The survey was designed to asses:

- -Degree of general knowledge the person has about the EU
- -Opinion on specific matters such as the 5 scenarios of the future of Europe and general satisfaction with the EU -Common EU myths and their sources

Event 2

Participation: The event involved 14.249 citizens, including 5.190 participants from Mallorca (**Spain**), 2.170 participants from the city of Rzeszow (**Poland**), 2.164 participants from Umbria (**Italy**), 2.110 participants from the city of Veile (**Denmark**) and 2.615 participants from the city of Lisbon (**Portugal**)

Location / Dates: The event took place in place in Mallorca (**Spain**), Rzeszow (**Poland**), Umbria (**Italy**), Vejle (**Denmark**) and Lisbon (**Portugal**), from 01.02.2019 to 31.12.2019

Short description: The aim of the event was to create informative 'question and answer' scenarios printed onto everyday objects and distribute them to various bars, restaurants, sports clubs and cafés. Furthermore, the partnership designed and distributed info graphics which explain what it is and how the EU functions and undertook an intensive social media campaign.

Event 3

Participation: The event involved 337 citizens, including 74 participants from Mallorca (**Spain**), 79 participants from the city of Rzeszow (**Poland**), 83 participants from the city of Vejle (**Denmark**) and 101 participants from the city of Lisbon (**Portugal**)

Location / Dates: The event took place in place in Mallorca (**Spain**), Rzeszow (**Poland**), Vejle (**Denmark**) and Lisbon (**Portugal**), from 01.02.2019 to 31.12.2019

Short description: The aim of the event was to provide citizens with a platform to voice their opinion and discuss the following subjects:

Debate 1. EU Parliament elections. Debate 2. EU Myths and Euroscepticism. Debate 3. Euroscepticism and the future of Europe. Debate 4. Real impact of the EU. Debate 5. Critical thinking and media. Debate 6. How to shape the future of the EU.

Event 4

Participation: The event involved 895 citizens, including 240 participants from Mallorca (**Spain**), 237 participants from the city of Rzeszow (**Poland**), 309 participants from the city of Vejle (**Denmark**) and 109 participants from the city of Lisbon (**Portugal**)

Location / Dates: The event took place in place in Mallorca (**Spain**), Rzeszow (**Poland**), Vejle (**Denmark**) and Lisbon (**Portugal**), from 01.05.2019 to 31.12.2019

Short description: The aim of the event was educate citizens in the different subjects, previously debated in Event 3: Webinar 1. EU Parliament elections. Webinar 2. EU Myths and Euroscepticism.
