Welcome to the third 4.0 ANDCOM Newsletter

The **4.0 didactic approaches in duty of developing ANDragog's COMpetences** project aims at introducing a new approach for the education of low-skilled and low qualified adults. **4.0 ANDCOM** focuses on the role of andragogs - adult educators- who plan, organize and conduct educational activities in a variety of adult educational centers and institutions. A total of **seven modules have been developed as m-learning courses for Andragogs** and will be available within the tool **"Industry 4.0 in teaching low-skilled adults"**:

- M1. Internet of things, in the context of pedagogical use in adult teaching.
- M2. Additive manufacturing, as an object of adult didactics.
- M3. Augmented reality, as a real alternative to analog didactic materials.
- M4. Robotics, which does not have to be difficult.
- M5. Cybersecurity, as basic necessity of every learning process.
- M6. Cloud computing, as the future for managing and storing data.
- M7. Artificial Intelligence, which can gear up adult education and future prospects.

In this third newsletter we will explain the structure of the Videos for Andragogs which are currently being developed and that will be soon available in their final versions on our YouTube channel. Video guidance is expected to raise the knowledge of didactic possibilities coming from Industry 4.0. Once the knowledge is acquired by the Andragogs, the impact can be expressed in the increased level and quality of adult knowledge transfer.

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Video guidance for Andragogs: "How to implement Industry 4.0 in teaching low-skilled adults effectively?"



- 3. Examples of classes using ...




