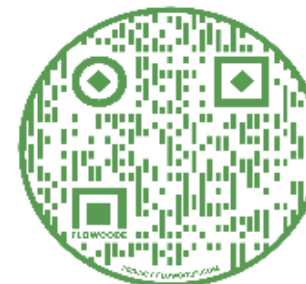
## The Rediscovery Centre, Ballymun.
