Entrepreneurship Training Program

ENTRE-FORWARD (Enhancing entrepreneurship skills) is an international project cofinanced by the European Commission under the Erasmus+ Programme; the project is implemented and developed by six organisations from six countries (Portugal, Poland, France, Italy, Spain & Greece) sharing the ultimate aim to support upskilling and raising awareness to educators, trainers and guidance practitioners in education training, employment, and the general public on the development of entrepreneurial skills.

WHAT IS IT?

This Training program seeks to address the need for a structured approach for the development of entrepreneurship knowledge and skills to young adults (students project holders, entrepreneurs) that will be implemented by adult trainers and counselors.

It aims to deal with Entrepreneurship as a theme and a method that can be embedded in all subjects and it will be adapted to selected domains such as health and social sciences, economy and business, art and culture, primary sector, construction and manufacturing, tourism and transportation etc.

WHAT DOES IT CONTAIN?

The Entrepreneurship Training Program represents a comprehensive toolbox comprising of:

- An overview of criteria and standards for training and assessment methods
- A Modular curriculum to support educators, trainers, guidance practitioners for helping young adults in order to adapt and update the relevant skills and knowledge according to the future needs in the entrepreneurship era.
- Learning materials for educators, trainers and guidance practitioners that will enable them to assist their students in assessing and improving specific skills needed in entrepreneurship and acquire knowledge on the legal and financing processes to run a business (i.e business plan, types of enterprises, etc). These materials will also be supported by links to the reputable professional associations to allow the guidance professionals to continuing update of the course content.
