Final Partners Transnational Meeting Marks Significant Milestone in STAND UP Project

The STAND UP - Fight against Cyberbullying in VET Classroom project reached a crucial point when partners from Greece, Spain, Poland and Ireland met in the beautiful city of Trikala, Greece for the project's final transnational meeting. Hosted by DIAS VET, the meeting took place on 18-19 October 2023 and was a defining moment in the joint efforts to combat cyberbullying in vocational education and training (VET) classrooms.

Partners from Spain, including Accion Laboral and Innohub, as well as representatives from Poland's CWEP and Ireland's Eurospeak, convened in Trikala to take part in discussions that focused on several critical areas of the project.



During the two-day meeting, participants had the opportunity to:

 Review the progress of the project: The partners made a comprehensive assessment of the progress of the project and highlighted the main achievements and milestones reached since the beginning of the project.

- **Final tasks and organisation**: In joint discussions, the essential tasks that are crucial for the completion of the project were defined in order to ensure that all objectives are achieved within the given time frame.
- Sustainability and future exploitation: The partners laid the groundwork for post-project success by developing strategies to sustain and maximise the project's outcomes well beyond its official conclusion in January 2024.

The STAND UP project aims to provide vocational teachers with tools to help them understand and combat cyberbullying. It also aims to help vocational students become aware of the danger of cyberbullying. The final transnational meeting allowed the project partners to reaffirm their commitment to this important task and to ensure that their efforts have a lasting impact on education and online safety.

The meeting was characterised by a spirit of cooperation, commitment and shared vision. All partners expressed their gratitude for the warm hospitality of the hosts, DIAS VET, who made the event a resounding success.

As the project moves closer to its conclusion in January 2024, the partners remain committed to making a significant and positive contribution to the fight against cyberbullying in VET classrooms.
